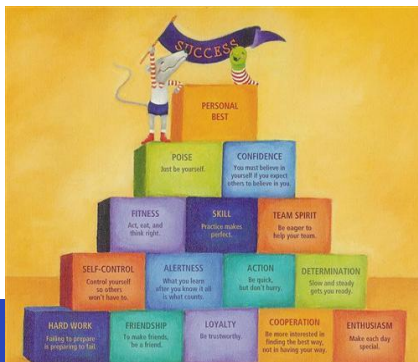

Parking Lot / Traffic

What can YOU do to improve the traffic in front of our school?

Many of the following infractions are happening everyday putting our students at risk!

- Driving too fast in a School Zone
- Driving on the wrong side of the road
- Jay Walking across the street in the midst of high traffic and poor visibility
- Children being picked up or dropped off anywhere other than the yellow loading/unloading zone
- Entering a parking area marked as EXIT ONLY



Safety aside, all of these infractions are subject to a citation by the Chino Hills Sheriff.

Perhaps you say to yourself, “just this once” or “I’m late and don’t have time” It only takes ONCE for a catastrophe to occur. What if that ONCE is YOU?

Please use Caution and proceed with the safety of our students (and yours) in mind!

- The yellow curb area is for loading/unloading only. Drivers must remain in your vehicle. If you need to exit your vehicle to assist your child in any way, you must use a parking stall.
- Students may enter/exit a vehicle on the curb side only of the loading/unloading area.
- Please pull your vehicle all the way forward in order to allow the flow of traffic to keep moving. Once you come to a complete stop, your student may enter/exit your vehicle.
- Always use the crosswalk, in the parking lot **and** on the street. NEVER signal to your student it is ok to proceed across the traffic lanes, with or without you.

● **SLOW DOWN!**

● **Always Expect the Unexpected!**

● **NEVER be on your cell phone while in a school zone!**

*Students should always be picked up in front of the school. Please don’t advise your child to meet you down the street to be picked up. Students cannot be supervised once they leave campus. The line of traffic looks worse than it is. Be patient, you will get there and your child will remain safe.
