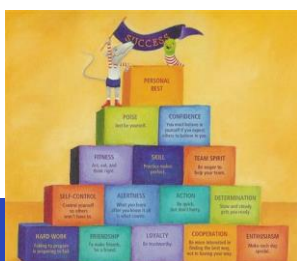

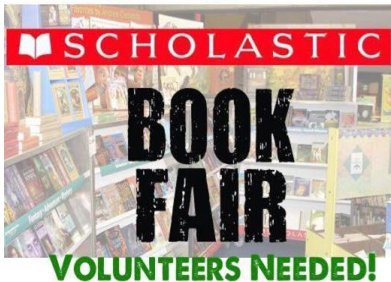
### A Reminder from the Health Office:
