- The Ayala Marching and Concert Percussion Ensembles traveled to Dayton, Ohio to compete in the Winter Guard International World Championships. The Marching Percussion Ensemble earned Bronze Medals in the World division and the Concert Percussion were named World Champions for the 8th time; more than any ensemble, and Ayala has now earned more Gold Medals that any other program in history.
- The Ayala Color guard were named WGASC World Class Gold Medalists at their championships for the first time in Ayala's history.
