

Child Development teacher receives special recognition from Associated Chino Teachers

Joann Bartel, head child development teacher at the Children's Center on the Chino Valley Adult School campus in Chino, has received special recognition by the Associated Chino Teachers (ACT) for her work at the center.

She was recognized at an ACT ceremony this spring and at the May 18 Chino Valley Unified School District Board of Education meeting at Woodcrest Junior High in Ontario.
