GREAT CALIFORNIA SHAKEOUT

Major earthquakes can cause unprecedented catastrophes. With earthquakes as an inevitable part of our future, schools should make plans and take actions to ensure that disasters do not become catastrophes. What we do now will determine what our lives will be like afterwards. The principles practiced here will apply to many other hazards. Schools also need to be prepared for fire, flood, hazardous materials release, and pandemics. With this in mind, the Earthquake Country Alliance (www.earthquakecountry.org) created the *Great ShakeOut*, an earthquake drill and preparedness activity in which everyone can participate.
