WHAT'S HAPPENING IN CLASS?

Have you noticed your child talking about listening ears or empathy? Or maybe saying "my turn, your turn?" Or how about yellow, green, or red sentences? Have you seen a number 1, 2, 3 or 4 rather than a percentage or letter grade? What is happening in class?

This year we have introduced two new curriculums to students - Second Step and Step Up to Writing. Second Step is a behavior curriculum that all students in grades TK-6th are using each day. Students are recognizing their own emotions as well as the emotions of others. They are solving conflicts and playing fairly to prevent conflicts. When students feel safe, they are better able to learn. A whole school approach allows us all to speak the same language.

Step Up to Writing is a new writing curriculum in which all students in grades K-6th are using.
SUTW supports specific standards in the areas of writing, vocabulary, language, reading, and speaking and listening. A school-wide approach to writing builds upon skills from one grade level to the next. A strong writing program has been a missing in our previous curriculums; we are excited to have an explicit approach to teach our students.

And what are those numbers coming home on assignments? The numbers 1, 2, 3, 4 align with the CVUSD Standards Based Grading Report Card debuting in November. The number identifies the child's mastery level of the standard. Most

standards are not expected to be mastered until the end of the school year. A score of a 1 (beginning) or a 2 (approaching) would mean you child is just learning those concepts. A score of a 3 (proficient) or a 4 (extending) would mean your child has mastered the standard or he has extended his thinking beyond the current grade level expectations. The end of the first trimester report card will give you a more complete picture of your child's progress.


