8 STANDARDS FOR MATHEMATICAL PRACTICE

or SMPs as we like to call them. What are they? When developing the Common Core Standards, educators noticed that there are 8 Standards for Mathematical Practice that are inherent in

every grade. These are Math practices that every child TK-12th grade should practice in order to become proficient. Parents can help by reinforcing these standards at home.

- #1 - Make sense of problems and persevere in solving them*
- #2 - Reason abstractly and quantitatively.*
- #3 - Construct viable arguments and critique the reasoning of others.*
- #4 - Model with mathematics.*
- #5 - Use appropriate tools strategically.*
- #6 - Attend to precision.*
- #7 - Look for and make use of structure.*
- #8 - Look for and express regularity in repeated reasoning.*

Over the last three years, CVUSD has been focusing on SMP 1, 3, and 6. Next year we will focus on other SMPs. For more information on what the SMPs mean, please visit
